Charged with:

Two Charges of professional misconduct contrary to Core Duty 5, Four Charges of professional misconduct contrary to Core Duty 9 and One Charge of professional misconduct contrary to Core Duty 10 and rC64.2, rC64, rS8 and rC64.1 of the Bar Standards board Handbook (1st Edition) – Behaving in a way that diminished the trust and confidence which the public places in a barrister or the profession; Failing to provide his Regulator, the Bar Standards Board, with information requested from him for the purpose of their regulatory functions; Failing to take reasonable steps to manage his practice and failing to comply with his legal and regulatory obligations; Failing to comply in due time with a sentence of a Disciplinary Tribunal.
