**CALL/INN:** Called to the Bar by Lincoln's Inn, July 1989

**TYPE OF HEARING:** 5 Person Disciplinary Tribunal

**DATE OF DECISION:** 12 November 2013

## **In breach of**

Contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

## **Details of Offence**

Frankie Tan Lyn Seang was struck off the Roll of Advocates and Solicitors of the High Court of Malaya by order of the Advocates and Solicitors Disciplinary Board dated the 19<sup>th</sup> November 2010 after a finding by the Board that Frankie Tan Lyn Seang was guilty of misconduct for acting dishonestly and fraudulently as he had witnesses and attested the alleged signature of the vendor knowing that it was a forgery. Being struck off comprises conduct which is dishonest or otherwise discreditable to a barrister contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) of the Code of Conduct of the Bar Council of England and Wales (8<sup>th</sup> Edition).

**SENTENCE:** Disbarred.

**STATUS:** Open to Appeal.
