Details of Offence

Henry Hendron on or before the 20th November 2013 being Head of Chambers did not take all reasonable steps to ensure that the affairs of his chambers were conducted in a manner which is fair and equitable for all barristers and pupils in that he failed to ensure that, in respect of fees earned by Rakesh Nath and billed by or on behalf of Rakesh Nath, the remuneration arrangements and the paying of Rakesh Nath were properly and efficiently administered.

Henry Hendron on or before the 20th November 2013 being Head of Chambers did not take all reasonable steps to ensure that the affairs of his chambers were conducted in a manner which is fair and equitable for all barristers and pupils in that he failed to give reasonable notice to Rakesh Nath to leave Chambers.

SENTENCE: Reprimanded. Fined £2000. Costs £65.86.

STATUS: Open to Appeal.
