## **Details of Offence**

William Byrne behaved in a way which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in the profession, contrary to Core Duty 5, in that on the 15<sup>th</sup> May 2015, he was convicted at Newcastle Magistrates Court of an offence under Section 5 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Schedule 2 to the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988 of driving a motor vehicle after consuming so much alcohol that the proportion of alcohol in his breath, namely 141 microgrammes of alcohol per 100 millilitres of breath.

**SENTENCE**: Fined £3,500.

**STATUS**: Open to Appeal.
