Charged with:

Professional misconduct contrary to rC71, rC64.1, Core Duty 9, rC123, rC131.2, Core Duties 5, 7 and 10 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook; Did not give the Legal Ombudsman all reasonable assistance by them; Did not promptly provide all such information to the Bar Standards Board for the purposes of its regulatory functions; Was not open and co-operative with his Regulators; Did not supply a public access client with written confirmation of the terms of his instruction; Did not return papers his client and their legal representatives; Acted in a way which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in a barrister or in the profession; Did not provide a competent standards of work and service; Did not take reasonable steps to manage his practice, or carry out his role within his practice competently and in such a way as to achieve compliance with his legal and regulatory obligations.
