TYPE OF HEARING: 5 Person Disciplinary Tribunal

DATE OF DECISION: 11 September 2013

In breach of

Contrary to paragraphs 301(a)(i) and 905(b)(v) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

Details of Offence

Ann Ng engaged in conduct which was discreditable to a barrister, in that while in practice as an advocate and solicitor, she failed to release to her client the balance of monies, amounting to RM 74,905.91 due to him from the sale and purchase of residential property, and in respect of such conduct on the 19th January 2012 she was ordered to be struck off the Roll of Advocates and Solicitors of the High Court of Malaya pursuant to a finding by a Disciplinary Committee of the Advocates and Solicitors Disciplinary Board on 21st September 2011 that she was guilty of misconduct.

Ann Ng failed to report promptly to the Bar Standards Board that she had been convicted of a disciplinary offence by another professional body, namely the Advocates and Solicitors Disciplinary Board of the Malaysian Bar.

SENTENCE: Disbarment.

STATUS: Open to Appeal.
