Paragraph 301(a)(iii) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

Details of Offence

Sean Minihan engaged in conduct likely to diminish public confidence in the legal profession or the administration of justice or otherwise bring the legal profession into disrepute contrary to paragraph 301(a)(iii), in that between the 20th of January 2010 and the 18th of March 2010 he caused detriment to his bankruptcy estate by failing to disclose monies received totalling £28,544 comprising of £9,052 received in hand for book debts accrued prior to the bankruptcy order and £19,492 of income earned following the commencement of the bankruptcy order, which sums he expended in the period.

SENTENCE: Reprimand Fined £500
