A practicing barrister, failed to provide a competent standard of service to his client, and/or he failed to take reasonable steps to manage his practice and/or failed to take reasonable steps to ensure the third-party payment service was consistent with his duty to act competently and in his client's best interests; behaved in a way which is likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in him or in the profession.
