**Charge 1**

### Statement of Offence

Professional misconduct, contrary to Core Duty 3 and/or Core Duty 5 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook (version 4.6).

### Particulars of Offence

Mariam El-Sobky, a practising barrister, failed to attend court hearings in the Family Court at Wolverhampton on 24 August 2022 and 14 November 2022 when she was still formally on the court record as acting for her client, she had been ordered or otherwise required by the Judge to attend both hearings, and the hearings had been listed wholly or partly for Ms El-Sobky to account for her actions in the proceedings and respond to the court's questions. In doing so, Ms El-Sobky acted without integrity and/or in such a way which is likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in her or in the profession.

**Findings:**

Charge 1	Proved in respect of 24 August 2022 hearing, but not as a breach of Core Duty 3.
Charge 2	Dismissed
