TYPE OF HEARING: 5 Person Disciplinary Tribunal

DATE OF DECISION: 11 September 2013

In breach of

Contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

Details of Offence

Yoong Heng Chan was struck off the Roll of Advocates and Solicitors of the High Court of Malaya by order of the Advocates and Solicitors Disciplinary Board dated 20th February 2010 on the basis that on or about the 6th August 2007, Yoong Heng Chan stole RM85000 from his lay client. Being struck off comprises conduct discreditable to a barrister contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales.

SENTENCE: Disbarment.
