Details of Offence

Tariq Rehman, being a self-employed barrister and having, on or about the 12th April 2012 received £2007.62 (including VAT) for work done by another barrister, failed to pay that amount to the barrister forthwith, such failure being a serious failure to comply with the provisions of the Code, in itself, but also by reason of his failure to respond adequately or at all to telephone calls and emails and a letter from the barrister's clerk between May 2012 and December 2012.

Tariq Rehman being a self-employed barrister and having, on or about the 12th April 2012 received £164.40 (including VAT) for work done by another barrister, failed to pay that amount to the barrister forthwith, such failure being a serious failure to comply with the provisions of the Code, in itself, but also by reason of his failure to respond adequately or at all to telephone calls and emails and a letter from the barrister's clerk between May 2012 and December 2012.

Tariq Rehman being a self-employed barrister and having, on or about the 12th April 2012 received £136.80 (including VAT) for work done by another barrister, Timothy Bass, failed to pay that amount to the barrister forthwith, such failure being a serious failure to comply with the provisions of the Code, in itself, but also by reason of his failure to respond adequately or at all to telephone calls and emails and a letter from the barrister's clerk between May 2012 and December 2012.

SENTENCE: 2 months suspension on each charge [concurrent].

STATUS: Final.
