Contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

Details of Offence

Edward Agbaje engaged in conduct which was dishonest to a barrister in that from on or about the 1st September 2004 to the 17th March 2012 he cheated the public revenue in relation to Value Added Tax and from on or about the 31st December 2008 to the 17th March 2012 he cheated the public revenue in relation to taxation due on his income arising from his profession as a barrister for which conduct he was, on the 14th March 2013 convicted at the Central Criminal Court and sentenced to 15 months' imprisonment.

SENTENCE: Disbarred.

STATUS: Final.
