Contrary to paragraphs 301(a)(i) and 905(b)(iii) and pursuant to paragraph 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

Details of Offence

Nadine Wilson-Ellis, a barrister, having been called to the Bar in November 2008 by Gray's Inn engaged in conduct discreditable to a barrister, contrary to paragraph 301(a)(i) of the Code of Conduct, in that from September 2008-2011 she fraudulently obtained financial assistance in respect of the letting of a council house contrary to the Fraud Act 2006, of which offences she was convicted at the Bristol Crown Court and sentenced on the 20th August 2013 to 7 months imprisonment.

Nadine Wilson-Ellis failed promptly or at all to report to the Bar Standards Board that she had been found guilty of 2 counts of dishonestly making false representations to make gain for herself or another or to cause loss to another or expose others to risk contrary to the Fraud Act 2006, of which offences she was convicted at Bristol Crown Court and sentenced on the 20th August 2013 to 7 months imprisonment, contrary to paragraph 905(b)(iii) of the Code of Conduct.

SENTENCE: Disbarred.
