

# Jonathan Oultram

**CALL/INN:** Called to the Bar by Middle Temple, November 1988

**TYPE OF HEARING:** 3/5 Person Disciplinary Tribunal

**DATE OF DECISION:** 19<sup>th</sup> February 2015

## **In breach of**

Contrary to paragraph 202(c) and pursuant to paragraph 901.5 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales (8th Edition).

## **Details of Offence**

From 13<sup>th</sup> March 2013 to the 5<sup>th</sup> January 2014, practised as a barrister, without having a practising certificate issued by the Bar Council, contrary to paragraph 202(c) of the Code of Conduct and the Practising Certificate Regulations (Annex D to the Code of Conduct) such failure to comply with the Code being a serious failure, and therefore constituting professional misconduct on his part, pursuant to paragraph 901.5 of the Code because:

- 1) it amounts to a criminal offence (by section 14 of the Legal Services Act 2000):
- 2) the failure lasted for 10 months;
- 3) failed to respond, when required by the BSB to do so, to an email dated the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2014, requesting his comments on the allegation; and/or
- 4) he has failed to comply with other provisions of the Code in the past, namely breaches of practising requirements and failures to complete CPD.

**SENTENCE:** Disbarred.

**STATUS:** Final - Appeal Dismissed
