Details of Offence

On or about the 1st May 2014, Martin Wynne Jones failed to take reasonable steps to manage his practise competently and in such a way as to achieve compliance with his legal and regulatory obligations in that he carried out a reserved activity by exercising a right of audience at the Central London County Court when he was not entitled to do so by reason of the fact that he did not have a practising certificate and were not authorised by the Bar Standards Board to carry out any reserved legal activity, and were not otherwise authorised to do so pursuant to the Legal Services Act 2008 (as amended).

Between 1st May 2014 and 22nd July 2014, Martin Wynne Jones failed to take reasonable steps to manage his practise competently and in such a way as to achieve compliance with his legal and regulatory obligations in that he practised as a barrister when not entitled to do so by reason of the fact that he did not have a practising certificate.

SENTENCE: 3 months suspension.

STATUS: Final.
