Details of Offence

Henry Hendron engaged in conduct which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence in which the public places in a barrister or the profession in that on the 23rd March 2016 at the Central Criminal Court, he pleaded guilty and was convicted of: i) On the 20th January 2015 possessing a controlled drug with intent to supply – Class B Other; ii) on the 20th January 2015 possessing a controlled drug with intent to supply a controlled drug of Class C – gammabutrolactone. On the 9th May 2016 he was sentenced to a compulsory (unpaid) work order of 140 hours, with a supervision requirement.

SENTENCE: 3 Years Suspension.

STATUS: Open to Appeal.
