Called to the Bar by: Gray's Inn, March 2012

Type of hearing: 5 Person Tribunal

Date of decision: 1 October 2019

In breach of:

Paragraph 902 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales [8th Edition].

Details of offence:

Naseem Bajwa, a barrister, dishonestly made a false declaration on the admission application form to Gray's Inn, in failing to disclose that he had been convicted of a disciplinary offence and fined by the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal, in that [a] on the 8 March 2011, he completed and signed an application form for admission to Gray's Inn which stated that he had never been convicted of a disciplinary offence by a professional or regulatory body; [b] Mr Naseem Bajwa had on 10 June 2010 been convicted of a disciplinary offence and fined by the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal; [c] Mr Naseem Bajwa acted dishonestly by making the declaration because he knew that the statement that he had never been convicted of a disciplinary offence by a professional or regulatory body was false.

Sanction: 12 Months Suspension [of Practising Certificate]

Status: Final.
