### RASHID AHMED

**Called to the Bar by:** Inner Temple, November 2001

**Type of hearing:** 3 Person Tribunal

**Date of decision:** 13 March 2020

**In breach of:**

Core Duty 5 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook.

**Details of offence:**

Rashid Ahmed, a BSB regulated person, behaved in a way which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in a barrister or in the profession in that on the 5 April 2018, he assaulted another. As a result of the assault, on 7 April 2018, he was convicted at Westminster Magistrates Court on admission of assault by beating contrary to s39 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988, for which conviction, he was sentenced [as varied on appeal at Isleworth Crown Court] to a 12 Month Community Order with the requirement of rehabilitation activity for 35 days and 180 hours of unpaid work, £85 costs and £85 victim surcharge.

**Sanction:** Suspended for 3 Months.

**Status:** Open to Appeal.
