## **SAMI UR RAHMAN**

Called to the Bar by: Lincoln's Inn, October 1996

Type of hearing: 3 Person Tribunal

In breach of:

Core Duty 5 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook.

## Details of offence:

Sami Rahman, behaved in a way which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in a barrister or in the profession in that he twice breached a non-molestation order made by the Family Court in Uxbridge on 27 March 2018 and served on him on or around 6 April 2018, by, without reasonable excuse: a] on 16 April 2018 he attended a property in Wembley, Middlesex and speaking to X and b] on 17 April 2018, attending a property in Northholt, Middlesex and speaking to X; which acts were prohibited by the order. As a result of the conduct, on 14 June 2018, he was convicted on admission of acting in breach of the non-molestation order and, on 11 March 2019, was sentenced by the Crown Court at Isleworth to a] a 12 month community order with a requirement to perform 80 hours of unpaid work within that period; b] a restraining order not to contact directly or indirectly x until further order; c] pay a victim surcharge o £85 and d] to pay £340 in prosecution costs.

Sanction: Suspended for 3 Months. £1000 Fine.
