Professional misconduct contrary to paragraphs 301 [a][iii] and 901.7 of the Code of Conduct of the Bar of England and Wales [8<sup>th</sup> Edition] and Core Duties 3,5,7 and 9 and Rules rC65.3 and rC65.7 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook; Engaged in conduct likely to diminish public confidence in the legal profession or in the administration of justice or otherwise bring the legal profession into disrepute; Failed to act with honesty and integrity; Acted in a way likely to diminish the trust and confidence in a barrister or in the profession; Failed to provide a competent standard of work and service to his clients; Failing to be open with his regulators and failed to report to the Bar Standards Board that regulatory or disciplinary action had been taken by another Approved Regulator.
