Charged with:

Professional misconduct contrary to Core Duties 3, 5, 9 and 10 and Rules rC8, rC9.1 and rC64.1 of the Bar Standards Board Handbook; Failed to act with honesty and integrity; Behaved in a way which is likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in a barrister or in the profession; Failed to be open and transparent with his regulator; Failed to take reasonable steps to manage his practice; Acted in a way which could reasonably be seen by the public to undermine his honesty and/or integrity; Failed to act with honesty and integrity in that he knowingly or recklessly misled or attempted to mislead another barrister; Failed to promptly provide all such information to the Bar Standards Board for the purpose of its regulatory functions.
